### Friday

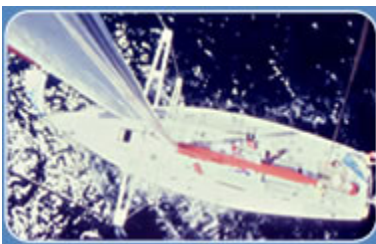
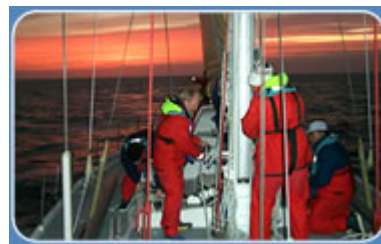
18.00 Join the yacht in Ocean Village

This yacht has raced in the toughest and most demanding oceans - demonstrating its outstanding seaworthiness. The yacht is safe and seaworthy in ultimate conditions and performs in a wide variety of environments. 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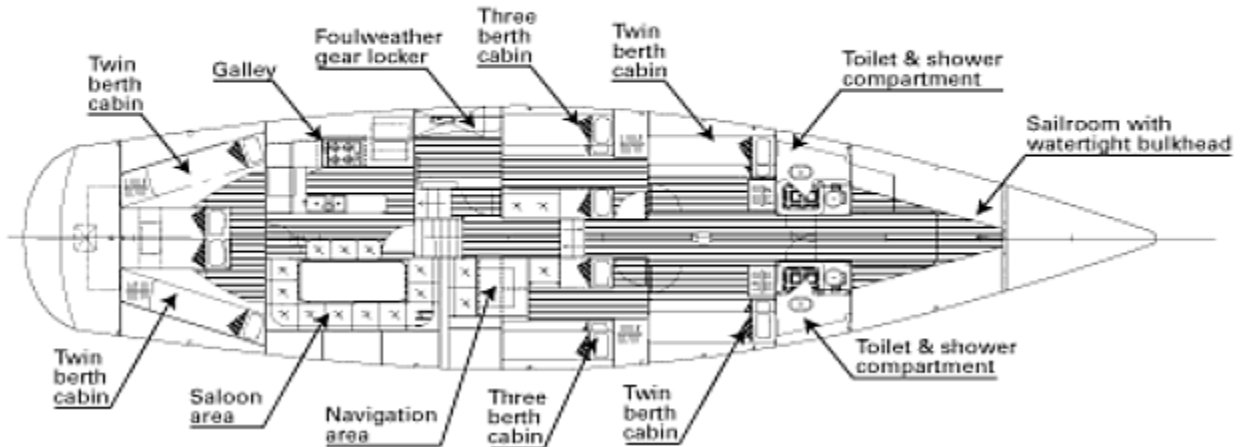

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## Sailing Weekend | Skipper

Stuart Jackson



Stuart owns and runs his Challenge 67' yacht Aurora of London. He was the youngest skipper in the fleet of the 2004/5 Global Challenge, attaining 2nd place on the Barclays Adventurer in the ten month race.

The Global Challenge, labeled The World's Toughest Yacht Race, finished on the 18<sup>th</sup> July 2005. Racing into the prevailing winds and currents, the twelve identical yachts crewed by sailors from all walks of life, encountered the worst weather on the planet. From the searing heat and windless Doldrums to the ferocity of a Southern Ocean Storm there was never a dull moment.

Following Stuart's success in the Global challenge he went on to become Regional International Trade Director for Barclays and now returns to the marine world and has his Yachtmaster Ocean qualification. Stuart is also a professional development consultant helping corporate teams reach their potential.

In 2000 he entered the ARC (Atlantic Rally for Cruisers), the largest transoceanic crossing in the world, sailing aboard his father's yacht. After arriving in the Caribbean with the ARC fleet Stuart sailed back to his homeland of Scotland single-handed, via Bermuda and the Azores.

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## Sailing Weekend | Cost

£350 per person or £3,500 for the whole yacht, to include:

- Wet weather gear
- Lifejackets
- All meals, snacks, soft drinks, bottled water, beer and wine onboard the yacht for the duration.
- Mooring Fees
- Fuel and use of all safety equipment
- Any drinks and meals ashore are not included.

## Event | Directions

### **How do I find the Yacht?**

We will meet at Harbour Lights Cinema in Ocean Village.

#### **From the North:**

Take the M3 to junction 14 and join the A33 to Southampton. Look out for the brown tourist signs marked 'Waterfront' and follow these signs into Canute road where Ocean Village will be signposted. Turn right at the traffic lights into Ocean Village Marina and just past the Red Calshott Spit lighthouse , turn left into the pay and display car park.

#### **From the West:**

Take the M27 to junction 3 and join the M271 towards Southampton. Look out for the brown tourist signs to 'Waterfront'. Follow the signs to Ocean Village passing via Orchard Place and Queens Terrace. Once in Canute Road Turn right at the traffic lights into Ocean Village Marina. Just past the red Calshott Spit lighthouse turn left into the pay and display car park.

#### **From the East:**

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Take the M27 to junction 7 and join the A334 towards Southampton. Look out for the brown tourist signs marked 'Waterfront' and follow these signs into Canute road where Ocean Village will be signposted. Turn right at the traffic lights into Ocean Village Marina and just past the Red Calshott Spit lighthouse turn left into the pay and display car park.

### **Car Parking**

Park at the far end near the harbour lights Cinema. The cost for the day is £8.00 please ensure you have change as the machines do not accept cards or notes. Alternative parking is available in the multistory car park on Neptune way behind the UCG cinema at £8.00 per day.

### **Arriving by train:**

There is a fast rail link from London Waterloo to Southampton Central with a journey time of one hour and twenty minutes. From the station Ocean village is a short taxi ride of less than 10 minutes.
